IN this two-part hands-on workshop led by artist Brenda Stuart, participants will learn about solarigraphy, a long-exposure photographic technique that captures the passage of the sun over a duration of time.

During the first session on Saturday, participants will explore various approaches of solarigraphy's uses, its history and how it works.

They will then create their own basic pinhole camera, load it with light-sensitive paper and receive instructions on how to set out the camera for optimal results.

Results will be revealed in the spring next year (date and location TBA) when participants will open their cameras to discover the sun trails captured. They will scan the photographic paper, digitally process it and share results as a group.

This workshop is suitable for adults and teenagers, and no previous experience is necessary. All materials provided. Pre-register by Friday.
